

# how to play noughts & crosses

*RealGames*

## **Objective**

Be the first to connect three noughts or crosses in a straight line.

## **Number of players**

Noughts & crosses is generally played by two because of how quick the game is!

## **Setting up**

Lay the playing grid on a flat surface, one player takes the five noughts, and the five crosses go to the other - that's it! You're ready to play :)

## **Playing**

Players take turns to place a single nought or cross on any vacant square of the grid, with the aim of achieving three in a row in any direction - vertically, horizontally or diagonally. The first to do so wins! If the grid is full, and neither player has achieved three consecutive noughts or crosses, the game's a tie.

## **Storage and care**

The Noughts & Crosses pieces and playing grid shouldn't be left outside but kept somewhere dry when not in use. Pop it all in the zip-up carry bag provided and tuck it away for your next game.
